

SICOP - QUICK SURVEY RESULTS

Is your state using AVL for winter operations?

State	Response	Comments
AK	Yes	We have done a couple trials. We are currently using Verizon Telematics but mostly for fleet management purposes.
CO	Yes	We are fully deployed with Zonar on all 970 plows. We are using Verizon on our light fleet.
CT	No	CT does not currently utilize AVL systems on any of its plow trucks.
DE	Yes	AVL on our entire winter fleet. 330 plow trucks.
IA	Yes	We are in the process of transitioning to a new GPS/AVL vendor. We awarded a new contract to Skyhawk Telematics in September to outfit all 900 of our snow plows.
IL	No	No additional comments
KS	No	At this time KDOT does not have any plow trucks equipped with AVL/GPS.
MI	Yes	We have AVL on all of our direct force winter maintenance trucks (around 300).
MN	Yes	We (MnDOT) are using AVL in our snow plows.
MO	No	We are exploring avl use and have done some pilots, but nothing widespread.
ND	Yes	On a portion of the fleet
NE	No	Nebraska doesn't currently have AVL on equipment but will have a RFP out in a couple weeks for this service.
NH	No	Not here yet but we currently have an RFP out for a limited deployment. Looking at the Turnpike sections (30 trucks +/-) as well as my southern I-93 section (15 trucks +/-)
NY	Yes	NYSDOT is using AVL on our plow trucks. We are using Verizon Network Fleet which transmits and tracks speed, location, and engine data.
OH	Yes	Ohio has a pilot project that is ran through the University of Akron. The project includes over 170 trucks. We have also put out an RFI to gather information from vendors to create an RFP. We hope to have the RFP out soon. The RFP will be for an addition 800 trucks, plus the incorporation of the original 170 trucks we already have in service.
PA	Yes	PennDOT currently has it deployed on 516 out of 2258 Department Force vehicles and 212 contracted plows with a plug-in "location only" unit. All of our new trucks will come with AVL installed and we are gradually retrofitting the rest of our fleet.
RI	Yes	AVL on all of our heavy winter fleet vehicles. Approximately 115 vehicles. We have numerous vehicles with AVL. We have about 400 in the NOVA District and another 250+ in the Salem District. The other eight Districts probably have about 50 or so in each District. NOVA requires most of their 4000 hired pieces of equipment to have AVL. In Salem, we require all of the hired trucks on our interstates and major primaries to have AVL. There is a mix in the other 8 Districts but most have some number of hired equipment with AVL.

VT	Yes	No additional comments
WA	Yes	Yes we are using AVL on approximately 400 of the 500 plow trucks in our fleet. We also have AVL on a number of our Incident Response Vehicles as well.
WI	Yes	No additional comments
